

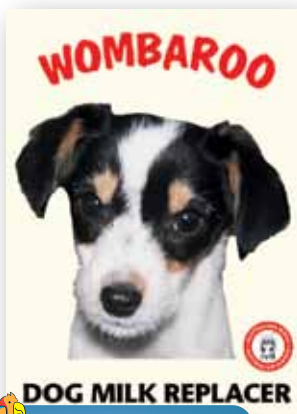
A nutritionally balanced milk substitute for puppies of all breeds. Use for orphaned pups or when the mother's milk is limited.

About Dog Milk

Different species of mammals produce milks of different composition in order to nourish their young. The table below outlines the differences between normal cow's milk and dog's milk.

	Cow	Dog
Solids (g/litre)	127	220
Protein %	26	33
Fat %	30	44
Lactose %	38	16
Energy (kJ/litre)	2800	5400

Dog milk has a high concentration of solids, with elevated fat and protein levels. However it is relatively low in lactose, with some puppies developing lactose-intolerance when fed formulas based on cow's milk. The high fat content of dog milk means that it has almost twice the energy density of cow's milk. This nutrient-rich milk supports the rapid growth rate of puppies. The type of fats present in the milk are important, with puppies developing best on milk containing adequate levels of omega 3 & 6 essential fatty acids such as EPA, DHA and linoleic acid.



Benefits of Wombaroo Dog Milk Replacer

- **Closely resembles Dog Milk** - formulated to match the average composition of bitch's milk, with added vitamins, minerals and essential fatty acids (omega 3 & 6).
- **Elevated Fat Content** - to provide for the high energy demands of growing puppies.
- **Low in Lactose** - to aid in digestion.

Using Dog Milk Replacer

- Success in rearing puppies greatly improves if they receive colostrum at birth. Puppies that don't get colostrum from the mother can be fed **Impact Colostrum Supplement**.
- Commence feeding milk formula after the initial feeds of colostrum. Make up Wombaroo at a concentration of 215g per litre, in accordance with the directions on the pack.
- Milk can be stored in the fridge for a day or frozen for up to a month. Small quantities can be frozen in ice-cube trays, so that the required daily feed volumes can be easily thawed out.
- When feeding, warm milk to about 35°C and feed from a bottle and teat (Wombaroo "SD" or "LD" type teats are recommended for small and large breeds respectively).
- Refer to the guidelines on the pack for feed rates. Do not overfeed as this can lead to diarrhoea.
- Weigh puppies regularly to verify consistent weight gains.

Whey proteins, caseins, whole milk solids, vegetable oils, omega-3 and omega-6 fatty acids (including linoleic, EPA & DHA), vitamins and minerals.
